## Taxpayer Relief (2022-23)

In accordance with the Taxpayer Relief Act of 2006, 5284 of homeowners that were approved for homestead/farmstead exclusions will see a property tax reduction itemized on their real estate tax bills. SESD's portion of the \$778.3 million in property tax relief from the state amounts to \$1,254,164.85. The homestead/farmstead reduction of the tax liability for the approved properties is \$237.48 for a property approved for 100% of the exclusion. The school property tax millage rate for July 1, 2022 is 22.2503 mills, and has not increased since July 1, 2016. On a property with an assessed value of \$100,000.00, the tax is \$2,225.03 (22.2503 x 100,000/1000).
