South Eastern School District Families:

Over the past few months the South Eastern School District has provided notification when a positive student/staff COVID-19 case was identified in our school district. As the result of some legal flexibility we have made the decision to send a weekly COVID-19 update to parents each Friday. These weekly updates will list new, identified COVID-19 cases over the course of the week, a link to our [SESD COVID-19 Positive Case Dashboard](#), and share any new guidance provided by Pennsylvania Department of Education or the Pennsylvania Department of Health. Please be aware that the [SESD COVID-19 Positive Case Dashboard](#) (see the table below) will share the most recent information regarding both the total positive cases in each building and the 14-day rolling count for each building. The 14-day rolling count will allow the district to follow the new Pennsylvania Department of Education [recommendations](#) for a short term closure due to a COVID-19 outbreak.

This week, the South Eastern School District has been informed of two confirmed cases of COVID-19. One case was at Kennard-Dale High School and the other was at South Eastern Middle School. Both confirmed cases are following the Pennsylvania Department of Health recommendations for isolation. For reasons of privacy, we cannot release the name of the specific individuals who tested positive.

We ask our families to continue monitoring your child(ren) for any symptoms of COVID-19 and to continue working with us to ensure the health and safety of our community. Individuals with COVID-19 may present with a wide range of symptoms ranging from mild to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with the following symptoms may have COVID-19:
