South Eastern School District Families:

This week, the South Eastern School District has been informed of four confirmed or presumed positive cases of COVID-19. Each of the four cases have come from a different building. The buildings affected by the cases were as follows: Kennard-Dale High School, South Eastern Intermediate School, Delta-Peach Bottom Elementary, and Fawn Area Elementary. The individuals with presumed or positive cases are following the Pennsylvania Department of Health recommendations for isolation. For reasons of privacy, we cannot release the names of the specific individuals who tested or are presumed positive.

Please be aware that the [SESD COVID-19 Positive Case Dashboard](#) (see the table below) will share the most recent information regarding both the total positive cases in each building and the 14-day rolling count for each building. The 14-day rolling count will allow the district to follow the new Pennsylvania Department of Education [recommendations](#) for a short term closure due to a COVID-19 outbreak.

As per guidance from the PA-DOH, the case count for a school building should include any individual (students or staff) with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19 who was physically present in the school setting while infectious, including but not limited to, instruction, work, sports, or extracurricular activities. Note that for the 14-day rolling count, dates are calculated by using the 0 date of Covid infection (date of symptom onset or positive test date if asymptomatic).

We ask our families to continue monitoring your child(ren) for any symptoms of COVID-19 and to continue working with us to ensure the health and safety of our community. Individuals with COVID-19 may present with a wide range of symptoms ranging from mild to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with the following symptoms may have COVID-19:
